

Dear Charter Families:

I am writing to you with new and important information. This afternoon, Governor Baker issued news of a mandatory extended period of closure, which applies to all schools in the Commonwealth. As a result, the Charter School is now closed through the end of the school year. The Commissioner was clear that school will continue in its remote form and students are expected to participate through the scheduled end of the school year.

There will be a conference call with Commissioner Riley on Friday afternoon. Following that call, and following his recommendations, I will be providing our families with more guidance related to the school closure for the remainder of the school year. I will also provide an update to the Charter School Remote Learning Plan.

Teachers are planning next steps and will continue to have connections with students. Look for information coming from each grade level of teachers as they have been sharing throughout the extended school closure. Please stay healthy and well and don't hesitate to reach out if we can be of assistance.
